Specification Guidelines For Recycling LDPE Nursery Film

Quality is the most important thing to keep in mind when recycling LDPE Nursery Film. In order to get the maximum recycling value from your material, it should be kept free of moisture and surface dirt.

- ▶ *Film should be taken off during a period of dry weather.*
- ▶ *Film should be kept from making contact with dirt.*
- ▶ *Baled film should be stored on pallets, preferably under a tarp.*

Packaging is a critical component of recycling large quantities of LDPE Nursery Film. Heavy shipments help minimize freight costs and consume less fuel.

- ▶ *Facilities with baler*
 - *Film should be baled to ensure heavy export container shipments*
- ▶ *Facilities without baler*
 - *Film should be rolled and tied up, producing easy to handle bundles*
 - *Bundles of film will be loaded into truck of preference.*

Price: Based on market conditions and location/material quality.

Size & Weight: 40,000 lbs /40' High Cube Export Container.

Contamination: 5% surface dirt & moisture will be tolerated.
