Specification Guidelines For Recycling PP Pots & PS Trays

Quality is the most important thing to keep in mind when recycling Horticultural Plastics. In order to get the maximum recycling value from your material, it should be kept free of moisture and surface dirt.

- ▶ *Trays/Pots should be nested only when dry.*
- ▶ *Trays/Pots should be shaken out prior to nesting.*
- ▶ *Trays/Pots should be nested and palletized securely.*

Packaging is a critical component of recycling large quantities of Horticultural Plastics. Heavy shipments help minimize freight costs and consume less fuel.

- ▶ *Trays/Pots should be nested and banded down on pallets (8 Foot Tall Pallets).*
- ▶ *Palletized Trays/Pots will be loaded into truck of preference (26 Pallets/53' Trailer).*

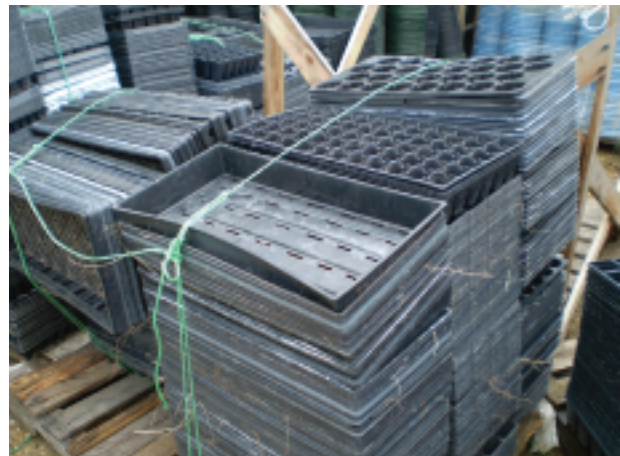
Size & Weight: 25,000 lbs /53' Trailer.

Contamination: 5% surface dirt & moisture will be tolerated.

Transportation: All transportation is handled by Universal Commodity Service, Inc.

Rebate: Based on market conditions and location/material quality.
